ORIGINAL PROCESS

- Student would need to fill out an application to graduate.
- Student would pay \$30 fee to graduate.
- Once payment posted, the student would end up on a list to be audited.
- Student would be audited and notified of results. (2-3 week process)
- This list was used to identify student who were eligible to walk in Commencement.

CHALLENGE


- Not every student filled out the application at the same interval.
 - > Some in Semester 1, others <u>after</u> they finished.
- \$30 was a genuine barrier for many students.
- Students who didn't apply in time didn't appear in the Commencement program and were potentially excluded from Commencement.
- Students who didn't apply were not certified as graduates, regardless of whether or not they wanted to participate in Commencement.

Question # 1: Why do students have to ask (apply) to graduate?



Answer I was given:

Because they have to tell us they want to graduate.




QUESTION # 2: WHAT IS THE COST TO ISSUE A DIPLOMA?



Answer:

If a student participates in Commencement, it costs \$11.

If a student does not participate in Commencement, it costs \$18.





...students were <u>automatically</u> audited (reviewed) after completing 30 college level credits?

...audits are done in February, June, and October?

...we added \$2.50 to the general fee to embed the graduation fee?

HOW IS THIS GOING TO HAPPEN?

SYSTEM LEVERAGE – ELLUCIAN COLLEAGUE

A primary job was built to identify students who meet the criteria of 30 completed college level credits, who do not yet have a record on SGRD. (This was done in collaboration with our IT department to verify correct mapping.)


Once the students are selected, a savelist is created and a second job is run to create the record on SGRD. The job is run using CGRF.

An informer report was mapped using the graduates file to gather information. We routinely access the information with its updates using a live excel.

These jobs are run nightly, so we always have the most current data of students hitting the 30 credit benchmark.

STEP 1 – POPULATING SGRD

When a student has completed 30 college level credits, their SGRD screen (graduation screen) is populated.



STEP 2 – CREATE LIVE EXCEL

Populates on spreadsheet with criteria listed here.

STEP 3 – THE EVAL PROCESS

Using BEVL, students are grouped together to do Batch Evaluations/Audits.

Students are notified of the audit results to their student email account using CRM Advise. The audit results are also documented on STRK in Colleague

If the student is going to be in their last semester during the Spring term, will only have two requirements outstanding at the end of the spring term, AND has a GPA above 2.0, the student is flagged as eligible for Commencement.


